Vineyard: 50% of this blend comes from our Cabernet Sauvignon block in the Napa Valley, and 50% was grown in our Smith block in the Livermore Valley.

Fermentation: The Napa and Livermore grapes were fermented in stainless steel tanks and pumped over twice daily.

Aging: The wine was aged for 22 months in French, American, Eastern European, and neutral oak barrels.

Description: Our 2010 Duetto exhibits rich flavors of black cherry, cassis, cocoa and chocolate. Accented by toasted oak and a hint of spice, this wine is both supple and bold with a long, rich finish.

History: Founded over 125 years ago, Wente Vineyards is the country's oldest continuously operated family-owned winery. Owned and managed today by the Fourth and Fifth Generations of the Wente family, the winery draws from nearly 3,000 acres of sustainably farmed estate vineyards in the Livermore Valley, San Francisco Bay, and Arroyo Seco, Monterey winegrowing regions to make an outstanding portfolio of wines.
