### VINEYARD

Sourced from our estate vineyards in Arroyo Seco, Monterey, our Coastal Selection Pinot Noir is grown in a region known better for its long and cool growing season. Rich limestone imparts earthy and mineral qualities in the wine.

### FERMENTATION

This wine was fermented in small stainless steel tanks and pumped over twice daily to maximize the extraction of all the wonderful flavors, aromas, and textures.

### AGING

This wine was aged for 16 months in a combination of 50% new French oak and 50% neutral oak barrels.

### DESCRIPTION

Our Coastal Selection Pinot Noir has notes of woodland strawberry, sassafras, and dusted cocoa.

### HISTORY

Founded in 1883, Wente Vineyards is the country's oldest continuously operated family-owned winery. Owned and managed today by the Fourth and Fifth Generations of the Wente family, the winery draws from nearly 3,000 acres of sustainably farmed estate vineyards in the Livermore Valley, San Francisco Bay, and Arroyo Seco, Monterey winegrowing regions to make an outstanding portfolio of wines.
