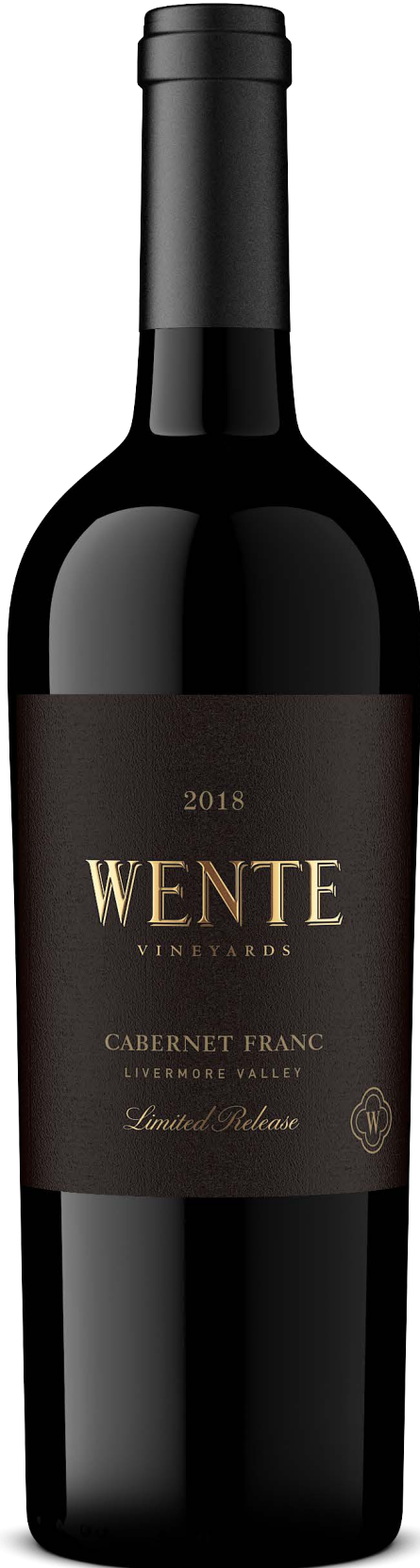

VINEYARD

Our small lot wine is harvested from carefully selected blocks that are estate grown and sustainably farmed. With an east-west valley orientation, the site gets warm days and cool nights that are influenced by fog and breezes from the San Francisco Bay and Pacific Ocean. The grapes are handpicked and sorted at harvest time in order to ensure premium quality.

WINEMAKING

FERMENTATION

Fermentation took place in small stainless steel fermenters where the wine was gently pumped over three times daily.

AGING

The wine was aged for eighteen months in 60% new and 40% second and third use French oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES

Our 2018 Cabernet Franc brings forth complex notes of green olive, fresh tea leaves and dark fruits. This Wine Club favorite is balanced by velvety tannins and a slight lingering acidity, making this perfect for food pairing.

HISTORY

Founded in 1883, Wente Vineyards is the country's oldest continuously operated family-owned winery. Owned and managed today by the Fourth and Fifth Generations of the Wente family, the winery draws from its acres of sustainably farmed estate vineyards in the Livermore Valley, San Francisco Bay, and Arroyo Seco, Monterey winegrowing regions to make an outstanding portfolio of wines.
