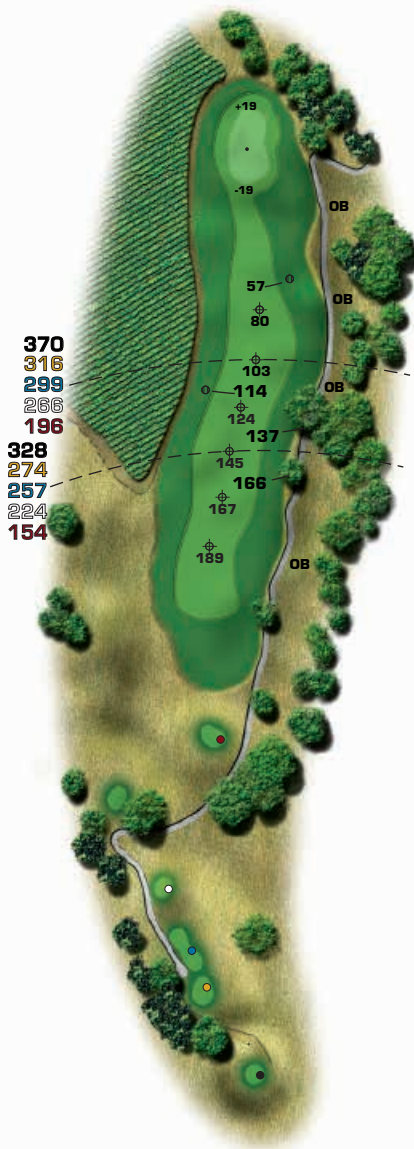
The dashed arcs are carry distances from the Tee boxes.

With a tee elevation of 100 feet this hole plays shorter than its yardage. The left center of the fairway is the favored placement off the tee. Make par here and your round is off to a good start.

*Caution: Please drive your cart slowly on the way down the hill, there is a lot of elevation change here and throughout the course.*

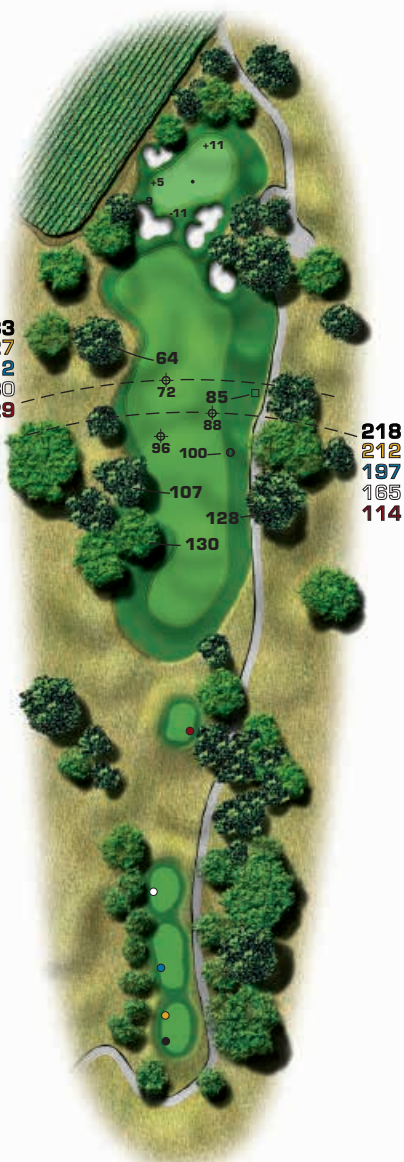

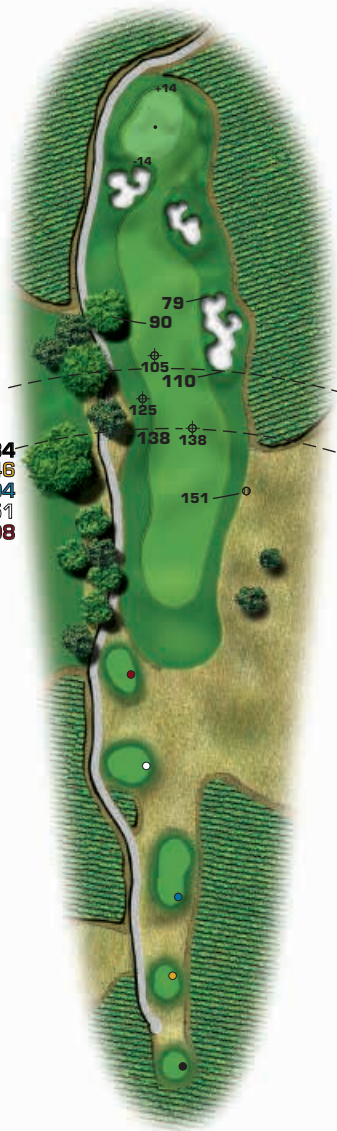

Typically into the wind, this par 4 requires precision from tee to green. The right center of the fairway is an ideal placement. Be cautious of the bunkers around the green; they are not as close to the putting surface as they seem.

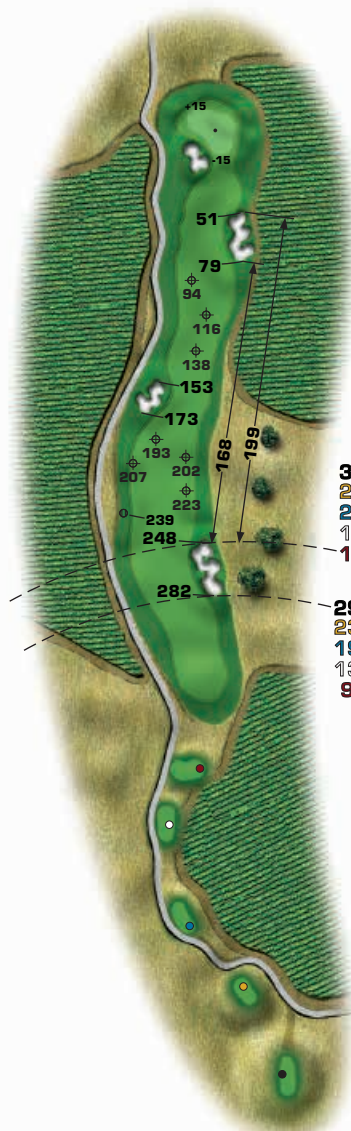

The shortest of the par fives on the course begins innocently enough with a straight-forward drive, but don't let this fool you. Vineyards surround the entire hole. Although tempting, and often reachable for the big hitter, a conservative second shot to the right center of the fairway can leave one in position to hit a short shot up close.

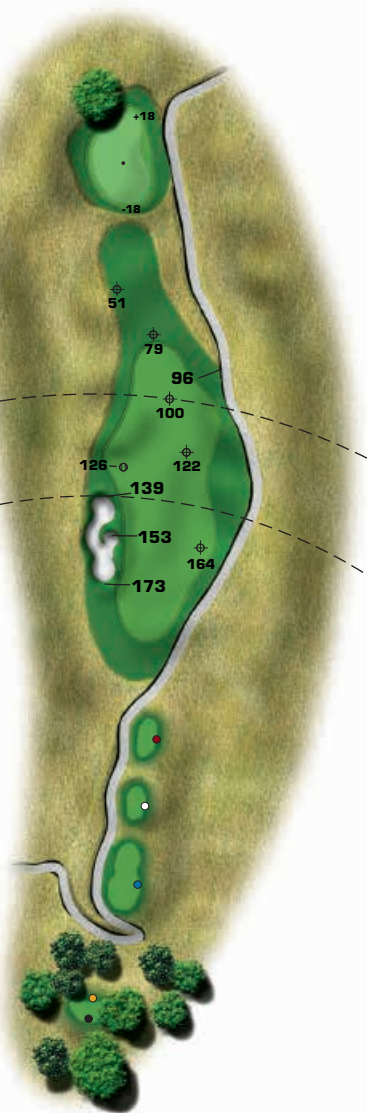
Length is a gamble on this short, uphill par 4. The wise tee shot is a conservative play off the tee. When hitting the approach, make sure enough club is in hand. With the front portion of this green sloping severely from back-to-front, a ball will easily roll off into the native grass.

This downhill par 3 can make your club selection difficult. With a sheltered prevailing wind from the left, the tee shot will play about a club short. Keeping your tee shot near the front of the green is a smart play due to bunkers left and right.

The longest hole on the course features a Greg Norman trademark target bunker off the tee. The second shot should be laid up short of the creek that divides the fairway. The third shot will be hit to an elevated green that slopes from back to front.

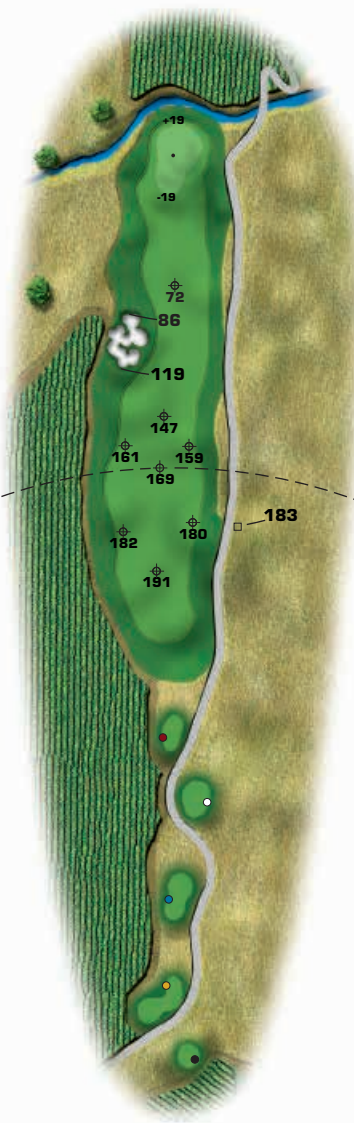


Time for the big drive on this long par 4. The tee shot is downhill into the prevailing wind. The fairway bunker is your line for the tee shot. The second shot plays uphill to a generously sized green. This green, like many of the others, slopes from back-to-front. Par here is a good way to go out on the front nine.

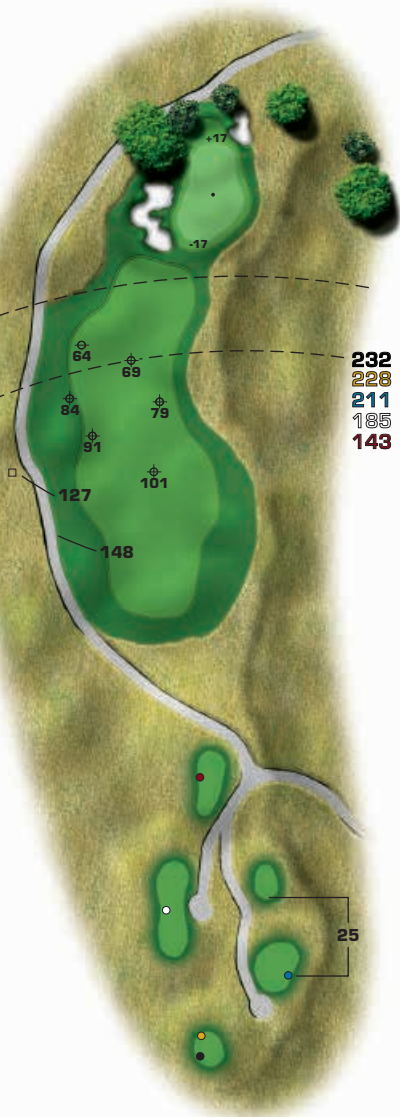

The bold play is the driver, but the wise choice is a middle iron to the wide area of the fairway. The short approach shot will give you the opportunity to get it close and start the back nine with a good score.

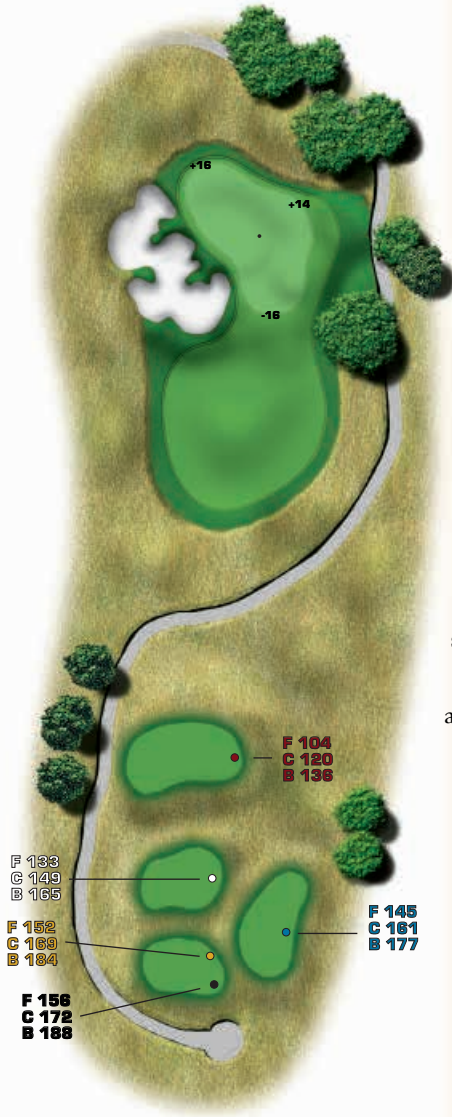

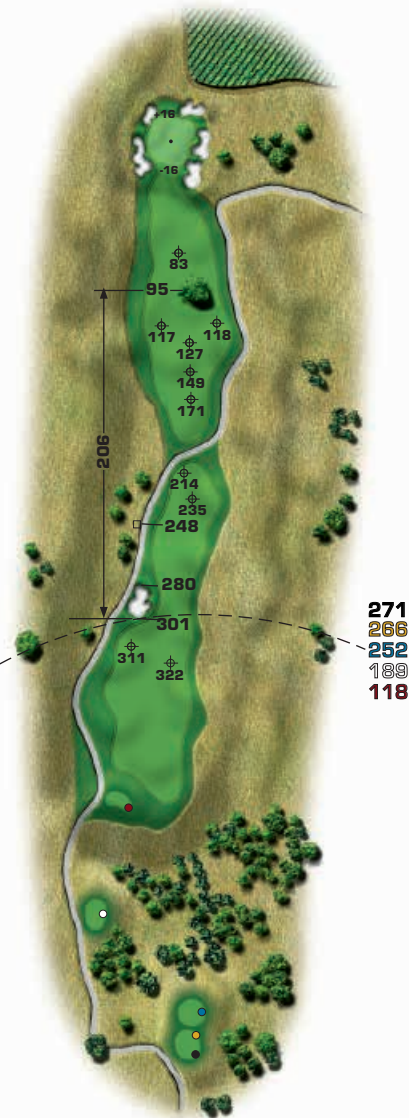

The tee shot on this par 5 plays into the wind, so aim for the fairway bunker on the left. The large oak in the fairway is the line for the second shot. The tree does come into play if you gamble for length, so make sure you choose your club accordingly. The approach shot into this well-protected, large green will be influenced by the wind.

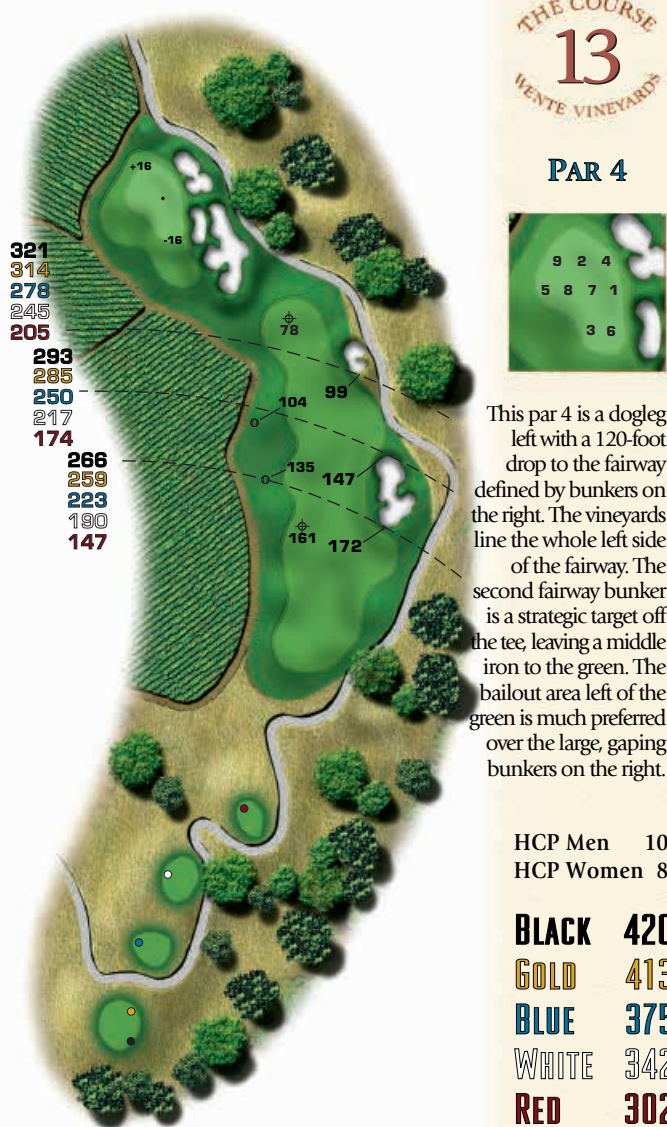

This par 4 is a dogleg left with a 120-foot drop to the fairway defined by bunkers on the right. The vineyards line the whole left side of the fairway. The second fairway bunker is a strategic target off the tee, leaving a middle iron to the green. The bailout area left of the green is much preferred over the large, gaping bunkers on the right.

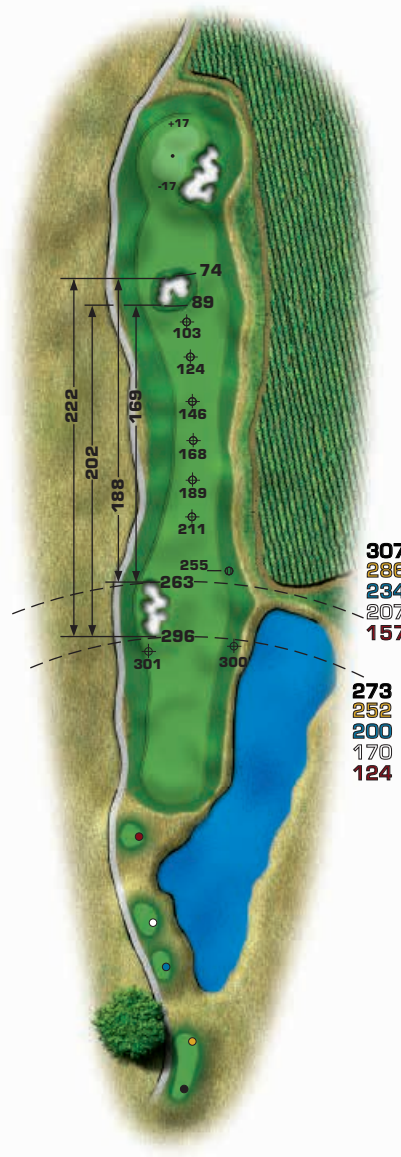

This is a reachable par 5 for the big hitter. The 15th hole typically plays down wind, with both a fairway bunker on the left and lake on the right. The second shot will be affected by the bunker in the middle of the fairway. Check your yardage; it is not as close to the green as it appears.

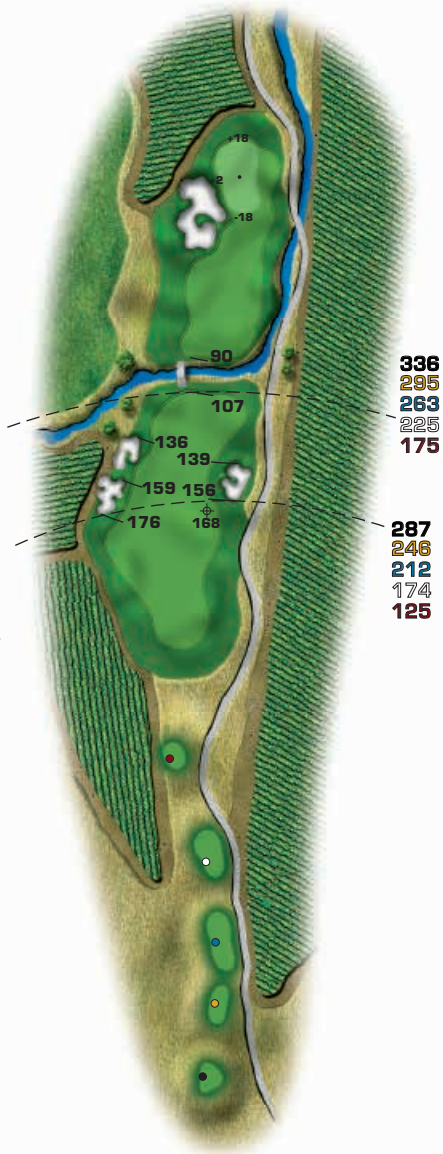

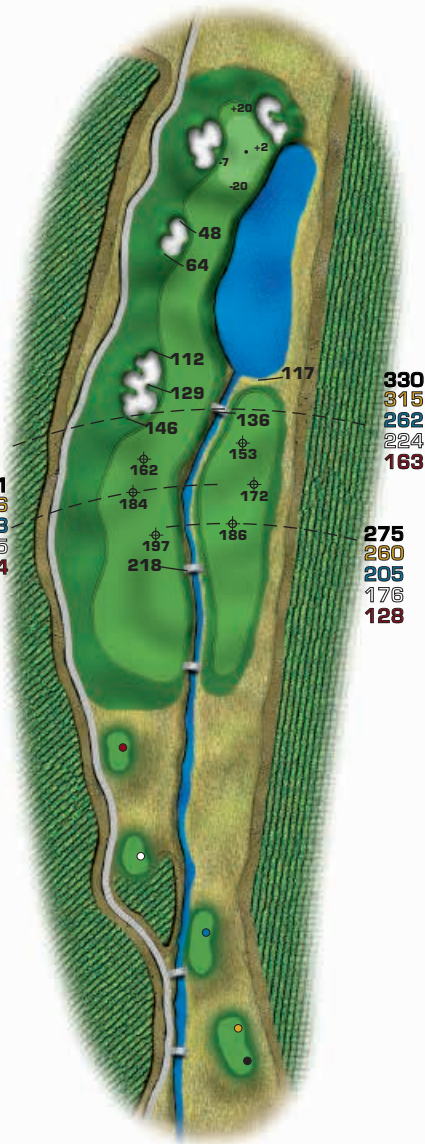
